MCSCC is comprised of companies, organizations, universities, and research institutes related to smart cities.

- The smart city project that MCSCC worked on in Masuda City was positioned as one of the Japanese government's "15 Prior Projects" by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism in 2019.
- In 2021, MCSCC conducted a Feasibility Study (FS) on MaaS, renewable energy, and infrastructure management in a special EV zone in Bali, Indonesia, with support from Ministry of Economics, Trade and Industry.
- In 2022, MCSCC signed a MoU with the Sanur Development Foundation in Bali, Indonesia, through the intermediary of the Bali Provincial Government, and established a cooperative framework for smart city development.
- In 2023, MCSCC, with support from the Agency for Natural Resources and Energy of Japanese Government, conducted a FS on the system of waste combustion power plant and EV bus charging facility in Jakarta.
